reading records.

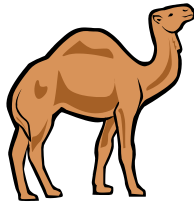
There will be weekly prizes and drawings as

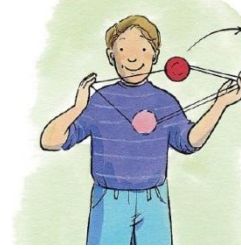

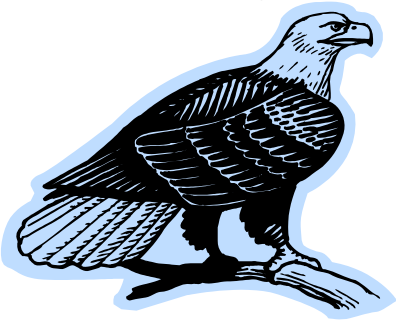

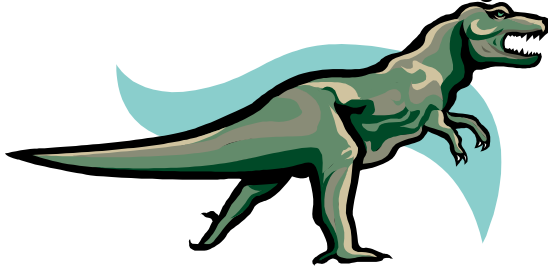
