## DEXTER DISTRICT LIBRARY FACTS

- The original Dexter Public Library was founded in 1927.
- In 1964, Dexter, Scio, and Webster Townships, the Village of Dexter, and the Dexter School District established the Dexter District Library and appointed a Board of Trustees to govern it.
- The Library's service area covers more than 85 square miles serving 16,000 residents in the Dexter School District.
- averaged more than 450 visitors per day checked out over 534,000 books, magazines, and audio-visual items
- was open to the public 72 hours per week, maintaining seven day per week service throughout the year
- hosted over 600 community meetings and library programs

- The FDDL was organized in 1958.
- Our major fundraising is accomplished by book sales.
- FDDL makes an annual donation to the Summer Reading Program
- FDDL purchased the fireplace and furniture in the adult quiet room (second level)
- FDDL assists with blood drives
