DEXTER DISTRICT LIBRARY FACTS

- The original Dexter Public Library was founded in 1927.
- In 1964, Dexter, Scio, and Webster Townships, the Village of Dexter, and the Dexter School District established the Dexter District Library and appointed a Board of Trustees to govern it.
- The Library's service area covers more than 85 square miles serving over 20,000 residents in the Dexter School District.

Annually the Library...

- averages more than 300 visitors per day
- checks out over 325,000 books, magazines, and electronic materials each year
- is open to the public 72 hours per week, maintaining seven-day per week service throughout the year
- hosts hundreds of community meetings and Library programs each year
