

Preschool Number Games



To play these games you will need to make large number cards out of construction paper. Cut your paper in half and write a single number on each half sheet with a black marker. You will also need masking tape, or any tape that is easily removable.

Number Eye Spy

- Walk around your home and tape the numbers to the walls in random order. Make sure to spread them out and mix them up. Hang them at eye level so your children can see them easily.
- Sit in a central location and call out numbers. Each time you call a number, have your children run around your home looking for it. When they find the number, they touch it and race back to you.

Number Hop

- Spread your number cards out on the floor in an area with some open space. You may want to add tape if your floor is slippery.
- Name a number and have your child hop, jump, or skip to that number card. Repeat with additional numbers.

Number Scavenger Hunt

- Lay your number cards out in order on the floor or on a table.
- For each number have your child find the same number of objects. They can find different objects for each number. For example they might bring back 2 stuffed animals for the number two and three Lego bricks for the number three.
- Count the objects together as they bring them back and place them on the number cards.
