Recycled Magazine Flowers



- 1. Find old magazines, or ads, that are going to be recycled. Look for bright colors.
- 2. Trace circles on the magazine paper using lids as templates. Make three different sizes. Cut out your circles.
- 3. Choose a paper circle and fold it in half. Fold it in half again. Cut sections out of the edges of your folded circle—these will be your petals. Unfold to reveal the flower shape. Repeat with your other paper circles.
- 4. Choose three different flower shapes and layer them from largest to smallest to create your flower. Glue the three flower shapes together.
- 5. Add a tiny circle of paper in a bright color to the very center of your flower. A circle sticker or button would work for a center too.
- 6. To make the stem, find a magazine page that has a lot of green. Tear out the whole page and roll it up at a diagonal. Roll it around a pencil to get the right shape. Tape the flower in a couple different places to secure.
- 7. Tape your stem to the back of your flower.
